Abraham Lincoln Memorial Hospital	200 Stahlhut Dr. Lincoln, IL 62656	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Park in back row of the front lot • Meet instructor in lobby • Wear whites • Bring all necessary clinical supplies
Decatur Memorial Hospital	2300 N. Edward St. Decatur, IL 62526	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Park in lot Q/R • Meet instructor in Cafeteria • Wear Whites • Bring all necessary clinical supplies

Please bring all necessary clinical supplies upon arrival to facilities:

- Stethoscope
- ID badge
- Pen light
- Black pen
- Watch with second hand
- Bandage scissors

Be sure to have your licenses plate number and make/model of vehicle for parking passes.

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*Dress casual clothing includes NON-DENIM dress pants or capris. No colored pants will be allowed, only gray, beiges, browns, and blacks. No leggings.

Shirts must be conservative with no V-necks, undergarments showing through or logos present.

Shirts must have sleeves (no tanks or spaghetti straps, or anything without sleeves).

Hooded garments are prohibited in all clinical facilities. Shoes are expected to be clean. Students should refrain from wearing sandals; open toed, open backed, high heeled shoes, or boots. Tennis shoes that are worn in clinical may be worn in MH facility; no tennis shoes with colors may be worn.

Jewelry guidelines the same...see Student Handbook. Tattoos need to be covered and visible piercings

removed. Lanyards are **strictly prohibited** in clinical. Students must use badge clips provided by

CASPN. Please dress in a professional manner as you are a representative of CASPN. Dress code will be strictly enforced.
