

Pediatric Clinical Syllabus

Quarter 4

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The pediatric rotation consists of 14 hours of clinical experience at Memorial Physician Services/Koke Mill facility.

Clinical Objectives:

Utilize critical thinking in the nursing process to care for children at all levels of physical and mental development.

1. Student will identify the different developmental stages of childhood via Erickson's psychosocial model.
2. Student will identify normal vital sign values for all ages of pediatric patients.
3. Student will identify proper immunization schedule for pediatric patients.
4. Student will describe nutritional needs of the pediatric patient.
5. Student will identify age appropriate toys/activities for the developmental stage.
6. Student will calculate pediatric medication doses.

Assignment:

1. Complete one Pediatric Information Sheet on a patient you assisted. Report findings in pre/post conference.
2. Discuss learning experiences in post conference.
3. Select 2 ATI questions (preferably related to a patient) and present in pre/post conference. Be prepared to explain the correct answer.

Clinical Guidelines:

Bring all required clinical equipment (stethoscope, pen light, pen, paper, scissors)

Bring pediatric textbook and ATI book
